Aerosol-cloud effective radiative forcing

Johannes Quaas is University Professor for Theoretical Meteorology at Leipzig University, Germany, since 2011. He worked at four of the main climate modelling centres in France, Germany, the UK and the USA. His expertise is in the role of clouds in global climate change, specifically the impact of anthropogenic aerosols on clouds. Johannes studies these using atmospheric modelling from local to global scales and from satellite observations. He served as a lead author for the 6th Assessment Report by the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change.
